**Equitation: English Hunt Seat**

Rider may ride in only one (1) English Hunt Seat Equitation class per show. That same person may ride in a Saddle Seat Equitation class at the same show only if a different horse is used. Rider should have a workmanlike appearance; seat and hands light and supple, conveying the impression of complete control should any emergency arise. Spurs of the untrowelled type, whips or crops optional; however, excessive use of the whip will be cause for dismissal from the class. Suitable hunt seat attire. No mixing of hunt and saddle seat equipment or attire. Class is to enter the ring and proceed around the ring at each gait, and on command, reverse and repeat. The order to reverse may be executed by turning either towards or away from the rail. Light contact with horse's mouth is recommended. Entries shall line up on command. A pattern may be substituted by or supplemented with rail work, so long as all three (3) gaits including both leads and a back are included in the pattern. Applies to all horsemanship and equitation classes except pony.
