

# 2011 Championship Show Class Schedule:

- **Thursday - 9/22/11** - Classes begin at 7 a.m. The last class of the day will be #23 Sr. Egg & Spoon-Pleasure. Showmanship classes will be run simultaneously.
- **Friday - 9/23/11** - Classes begin at 7 a.m. with classes #24 PW Western Pleasure. The last class of the day will be #39 Tandem Bareback.
- **Saturday - 9/24/11** - Classes begin at 7 a.m. with class #40 Sr.+ Jumping Figure Eight. The last class of the day will be #49 Four-In-A-Line.
- **Sunday - 9/25/11** - Classes begin at 7 a.m. with classes #50 and #51 (Sr. Speed Dash and Int. Speed Dash) running simultaneously. Class 50 thru Class 68 will be run simultaneously. The last class of the day will be #68 Sr. Pennant.
- **Monday - 9/26/11** - Classes begin at 7 a.m. with class #69 Pet Pony Barrels. The royalty coronation will be held after class #72 Jr. Barrels. The last class of the day is #76 35++ Barrels.

## Qualifications:

- Qualification dates for the 2011 WSCA Championship Show are from 8/24/10 thru 8/22/11. You must have qualified between those dates to be eligible to enter.  
\* **Note: Entries postmarked after 8/22/11 must pay "post entry fee rates." NO EXCEPTIONS!**
- Riders must be a member in good standing of a WSCA saddle club as of May 31, 2011, and their name must appear on the membership list.
- Riders must have placed either first or second at a WSCA judged horse show in a WSCA qualifying class within the qualifying dates listed above.
- Riders must ride in their appropriate age class, and correct pony size corresponding to age. Class and age divisions are to be determined as of January 1, 2011. Class and age divisions are:

Pet Pony	48" and under pony, rider 10 years and under
Pony	54" and under pony, rider 13 years and under
Pee Wee	Pony over 54" or horse, rider 10 years and under
Junior	Rider 11 to 13 years
Intermediate	Rider 14 to 17 years
Senior	Rider 18 to 34 years
Sr.+	Rider 35 to 49 years
Sr.++	Rider 50 years and over
- A rider and/or horse may enter and ride in only ONE 4-in-line barrel team.
- A Western Bridle Path horse must have a full and natural mane and tail and cannot show in another Western Pleasure Class. The Bridle Path horse is to be collected; moving with natural animation and an obvious degree of carriage.
- All Ponies **MUST** be measured at the Champ Show prior to their class. Ponies must show in their appropriate size and age appropriate class.
- **A COPY OF EACH HORSE'S COGGINS PAPERS ARE REQUIRED TO BE SENT WITH THE ENTRIES. Bring the original Coggins paper along to the show to be available to the show veterinarian upon request.**
- Refunds for entry fees will be given only in the case of an illness or injury to the horse or rider. A doctor's letter, or a letter from your veterinarian stating the reason you cannot participate, **MUST** be submitted to the show office. Refunds for any other reason will not be given. **No refunds will be given for stalls.**
