

WSCA 2011 Stalling Options and Instructions

PLEASE READ BEFORE YOU SEND IN YOUR STALLING REQUEST

- 1. Stall Request Cut-off** date is 8/22/11. Everyone is encouraged to send your stalling requests in early. Once the box stalls have been filled & there are no box stalls available, any requests for box stalls will automatically be assigned a tie-stall **regardless if received before cut-off date**. You will not receive any notification until you arrive at the show. Refunds for the difference between box stall options & tie stall option will be given. (Example: You sent in for one A option \$90 box stall but instead receive one \$20 tie stall, you would receive a refund of \$60). Refunds will be issued 4-6 weeks after the show.
 - 2. Entries.** Each Champ Show entry form **MUST** have a completed stalling form. Each horse must be accounted for in either a box stall or tie stall. No entry will be accepted without a stalling form completed. If your stall or entry form is held-up due to incomplete information, incorrect fees or another reason, you & your group will not be assigned any stalls until the issue is resolved. This could result in no box stalls available for the entire group. One horse allowed per stall per option.
 - 3. Box Stall Options.** The day & time requirements on the box stall options has been changed. A, B and C options are offered again this year. There are a limited amount of box stalls & when they are filled, tie-stalls will automatically be assigned and you will not receive any notification until you arrive at the show. As in the past, you may share stalls with another contestant and they **MUST** be sent in together or you will not be entered or your form could be delayed. This could result in no box stall available.
 - **Option A** - \$90 is the Full Show from Wednesday 4 PM to Monday night.
 - **Option B** - \$45 is from Wednesday to Friday 7 PM or one hour after your last class.
You must be out of your stall by 7 PM or one hour after your last class on Friday.
 - **Option C** - \$45 is from Friday 9 PM until Monday. You **cannot** get into your stall before 9 PM on Friday.
- No forms will be processed unless filled out correctly and completely. If you have questions or are not clear on something, it is your responsibility to contact the Stalling Coordinator - Tim Wampfler 715-497-6922 or 612-799-6105 or email at wampy81@yahoo.com**
- 4. Tack Stalls.** There are 3 horses required per tack stall. It is your responsibility to have 3 horses with each tack stall request. Tack stall requests not sent in together will not be honored and you will not receive a tack stall – No Exceptions. Tack stalls are also charged according to the A, B or C options and require the same \$35 deposit per stall.
 - 5. Tie Stalls.** \$20 per tie stall. A \$35 deposit per tie stall is required.
 - 6. In/Out Permits.** In/Out Permits are not being offered this year. If you are showing only one day or normally choose the In/Out Permit option, you could choose the Tie Stall option instead.
 - 7. Deposits.** All options for Box Stalls, Tie Stalls, and Tack Stalls require a \$35 deposit per stall. Deposit checks are returned after you clean out your stall/s and check out with the barn office before you leave. Every option must check out with the barn office before you leave or your check will be cashed. **There are no refunds for forgetting to check out – NO EXCEPTIONS.** A **separate** check **must** be sent for stall deposits. If there is not a separate stall deposit check sent, you will not be assigned a stall until the deposit check is received. If you are sharing stalls or sending in as a group, this will delay all persons stalling with you. This could result in no box stalls available.
 - 8. Refunds.** There are no refunds on stalling unless you requested a box stall and were assigned a tie-stall instead. If you are unable to attend the show as planned, you should notify the Stalling Coordinator or you may rent your stall to someone else as long as you coordinate this with the Barn Office Manager and/or Stalling Coordinator. You will not receive a refund for your stall however your stalling form with deposit check needs to be removed or your deposit check will be cashed. Failure to notify the Barn Office Manager or Stalling Coordinator will result in your deposit check being cashed. The WSCA does not give refunds on deposit checks when the procedure is not followed or forgotten.
 - 9. Check-in/Set-up day** is Wednesday, September 21 at 4 PM for option A & B. The barns & barn office will open at 4 PM. Please - Do not bring your trailer or horse in any earlier. Stall assignments will not be posted until 4 PM and stall assignments are not given out before 4 PM for any reason. No one is allowed in the barn or trailer area before 4 PM. Check in time for Option C is 9 PM on Friday, September 24. No one with an Option C stall will be allowed in the barn before that time. **NO EXCEPTIONS!** Barn office hours are: Wednesday from 4 PM to 9 PM, Thursday from 6 AM to 9 PM, Friday from 6 AM until 11 PM. Saturday & Sunday 6 AM to 9 PM and Monday 6 AM to 2 hours following the end of the show. These hours are subject to change - Barn Office hours will be posted outside the barn office during the show.
 - 10. Queen Contestants** - Send your stalling information to the person listed in the Spotlight as head of the Queen's Contest. Send your Champ Show class entries to Karen Whitaker; 1420 State Highway 15; Fairmont, MN 56031 along with a note indicating your horse will be stalled with the Queen Contestants. If you are bringing additional horses and are requesting them to be stalled near the Queens Contestants stalls, you must enclose a Stalling Form with your entries for those additional horses. Sending these requests in early will help make sure your additional horses are near you & the Queens Contestants stalls. Waiting to send these requests in could result in no box stalls available & your additional horses will be in tie-stalls.
